

Beim Goods Accessibility TTS Tool Privacy Policy

Effective Date: May 31, 2026

Last Updated: June 7, 2026

Scope: This Privacy Policy applies exclusively to the Beim Goods Accessibility Text-to-Speech Tool (Phase 1). Separate privacy policies will govern future product and service rollouts.

Our Privacy Commitment

Beim Goods is built on a privacy-first principle: we collect the minimum information necessary to operate the service and nothing more. We do not collect, store, or sell personal information.

1. Who We Are

Beim Goods is registered in Texas. We operate the Beim Goods Accessibility TTS Tool browser extension ("the Extension").

2. What We Collect

Information we collect

- **Install token:** a randomly generated anonymous identifier created when you install the Extension. It has no connection to your identity, browser profile, email, or any personal information.
- **License ID:** an opaque identifier assigned when you subscribe, used only to verify your subscription status.
- **Trial start date:** the timestamp when your trial began, used to calculate days remaining.
- **Subscription status:** active, trial, or expired, used to gate TTS functionality.

Information we do NOT collect

- Your personal info

- Your IP address (not stored or logged)
- Browsing history or activity on any website
- The content in TTS
- Your usage time, pattern, on/off etc.
- Any information about the websites you visit
- Device identifiers beyond the anonymous tokens, IDs etc.

3. Payment Information

Payments are processed by Stripe on their platform. When you subscribe:

- You enter payment details directly on Stripe's checkout page, which is hosted and controlled by Stripe.
- Beim Goods never receives, sees, or stores your credit card number, billing address.
- Stripe processes your payment and sends our server a notification. Our system reads only the anonymous license ID and tokens from that notification. No personal billing information is extracted.
- Your Stripe name, email address and the last 4 digits of your payment info is made visible to us by Stripe on Stripe's dashboard. We are unable to disable this.
- Stripe's handling of your payment data is governed by Stripe's own Privacy Policy at stripe.com/privacy.

4. How We Use Information

The anonymous token and license status are used solely to:

- Determine whether your trial is active, expiring, or expired
- Verify that you have an active subscription
- Display appropriate in-browser notifications about your trial or subscription status

We do not use this information for advertising, analytics, profiling, or any purpose other than operating the Extension.

5. Data Storage

Your anonymous token and license status are stored in:

- Your browser's local storage (e.g. `chrome.storage.local`), on your device only
- Cloudflare, our server-side storage, containing only the anonymous install token and subscription status. No personal data is stored on our side.

6. Data Sharing

- We do not sell, rent, or share your information with third parties.

- Stripe processes your payment on their platform. They receive billing information you enter directly on their checkout page.
- Cloudflare hosts our infrastructure and may process request metadata in accordance with Cloudflare's privacy policy at cloudflare.com/privacypolicy.

7. Cookies and Tracking

The Extension does not use cookies, tracking pixels, fingerprinting, or any analytics tools. We do not track your behavior.

8. Data Retention

Your anonymous token and subscription status are retained for as long as you have an active subscription or an installed Extension. If you uninstall the Extension and/or your subscription lapses, your data is eligible for deletion upon request.

9. Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect any information from children.

10. Your Rights

Because we collect no personal data, most privacy rights (access, correction, portability) do not apply in practice. However, you may:

- Request deletion of your anonymous install token and license record (See Data Retention)
- Contact us with any privacy questions or concerns

11. CCPA and GDPR

We do not sell personal information. We do not collect personal information as defined under the California Consumer Privacy Act.

Where EU data protection law applies, we process anonymous technical identifiers on the basis of legitimate interests in operating and securing the service.

12. Future Products

This Privacy Policy applies only to the Beim Goods Accessibility TTS Tool (Phase 1). Future Beim Goods products, including hardware devices and features, will be governed by separate privacy policies published at the time of their release.

13. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy. Changes will be posted at beimgoods.com with an updated effective date. Continued use of the Extension constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.
